2:20 PM ....Lope Assessment for all Intermediate and Advanced Riding Guests

**Location:** Outdoor Arena

*This lope assessment is to ensure that all advanced and intermediate riders are matched correctly with their horse. Each advanced and intermediate rider must demonstrate that they can post the trot, sit the trot and lope all while respecting the horse. Riders will be asked to lope away from the group as well as lope toward the group. We are looking for riders to demonstrate control, soft hands, and a well-balanced seat and feel.*

**Note: Mandatory for all guests who wish to participate in Intermediate or Advanced Trail Rides throughout the remainder of the week.**

5:30 PM....Horses and Happy Hour and Herd Tour in Pasture

**Location:** East Meadow

*Enjoy a few adult cocktails while you mingle among our herd of 200 horses. Learn to recognize the different social structures within the herd. Find your assigned horse and learn about his/her group of friends and where they fall in the social hierarchy of the herd. Do not forget your cameras! This is a great chance to get some beautiful photos.*

*Our Cattle Sorting Ride is designed for our advanced and intermediate guests. Mount up and head to the pasture, where you'll locate and gather the cattle, driving them into the arena. Once in the arena, you'll team up to identify and separate a specific numbered cow into a designated pen. This activity emphasizes control and advanced riding skills, including maneuvers like turning on the haunches. It's a thrilling and skillful experience that combines teamwork, precision, and horsemanship. Open to all Advanced-Intermediate riders who participated in the lope assessment.*

*All Instructional Rides will be split into different levels. We will concentrate on making sure all riders have control at the trot, are able to sit and post the trot, and have a general understanding of riding basics and horsemanship. Demonstration of control at the trot and a good seat is required before lope rides. Basic Refresher and instructional rides will advance as the week continues.*

### Open to all Basic Refresher, Instructional, Intermediate and Advanced Riders

*This working cattle ranch ride will head out to Wilson pasture (675 acres) to check on our head of cattle, with local Cattle Rancher, Merrit Lynke. With such a large pasture to explore, guests may spend up to half the experience searching for the cattle while ensuring our 5 mile of fence is intact. Once located, guests will assess the cattle for any injuries and potentially work to push the cattle to different areas of the pasture. Guests will enjoy a sack lunch and spend most of the day riding and working out in Wilson pasture, while learning about pasturing cattle in the high country.*

*Note: All riders should be comfortable with the walk, trot, and lope on uneven terrain and should be able to mount from the ground without assistance. Riders will be unsupervised at times during this experience.*

By Request ..... Grooming Clinics Available - Non-Riding Experience

*Learn how to maneuver your horse through our trail obstacle course. Deepen your communication and trust with your horse as you ride over many of our custom trail obstacles. From balance beams to teeter totters, our obstacle course has something for every level of rider. Our trail obstacles are setup out on one of our popular trails. Ask your wrangler about heading that way if you would like to try out the obstacles during your trail ride!*

By Request ..... Horsemanship Round Pen Clinic - Non-Riding Experience

**Location:** Indoor Arena

*Immerse yourself in our Round Pen Clinic, where you'll learn to communicate with your horse from the ground using subtle body language cues. This clinic focuses on controlling your horse's feet, movement, direction, and pace through positive reinforcement. You'll gain insights into how horses communicate and work on building a strong partnership between you and your horse. We'll practice working with a halter and lead rope utilizing natural horsemanship principles. Key skills include leading, stopping, backing, circle work, and lateral flexion. The round pen setting allows for a closer, more personal interaction between you and your horse—enhancing your communication and understanding.*

By Request ..... Wagon Ride & Driving Team Demonstration

**Location:** Pickup Near the Yurt Deck

*Enjoy the transportation of the Old West in style in our horse-drawn wagon! This scenic ride explores our pasture lands while showcasing our teams talent and educating guests on the different aspects that go into driving a team. Suitable for all ages, this experience is a perfect way to spend horse time with any non-riders you may have in your family. Capacity is 10 people and lasts approximately 30 minutes. Please note, this activity is in lieu of a trail ride. Typically 24-hour notice is required.*
